Computer and Printer Donation Guidelines:

ISM accepts Macintosh (PowerPC and Intel) based computers and HP Laserjet family printers.

Computers:

All units must be operational with (see minimum specifications below for more details):

- at least 256MB of RAM memory
- 10GB of hard disk storage
- a CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive
- an ethernet network interface card (or 802.11b/g wireless interface)
- Macintosh: Macintosh G3 or higher with a firewire (required) port

To be immediately usable, computers should be accompanied by:

- a legal copy of Mac OS X (Panther or Tiger)
- an XGA-compatible monitor (a resolution of 1024x768)
- a USB keyboard and mouse

Deployment and placement of donated equipment will be distributed by ISM Administration. ISM reserves the right to allocate all donated resources based on current priorities and requirements determined by the Executive Director or designee.

We will not accept:

- Inoperative or broken machines (includes scanners, printers, computers, and other devices)
- Apple IIe's, Older Macintosh Machines or Pre-G3 PowerPCs
- Intel Pentium or earlier machines (unless without specific prior approval)
- Monitors with resolutions less than 1024x768
